Dear ISGPB 2021 delegates,

We want to thank everyone that contributed towards the symposium by registering and uploading their files for presentations or posters. We are also grateful for the Scientific Committee members that agreed to act as moderators for the different sessions and judges for the ISHS Young Mind awards.

This newsletter contains some important information on the final arrangements:

All plenary presenters and moderators will have a practice session on 25 October 2021, while all live presenters will have a practice session on 26 October 2021. Workshop presenters will be able to rehearse on 27 October 2021.

Presenters/moderators will receive an email on Friday, 22 October 2021 with the rehearsal link. On their specific rehearsal day, they can log in at any time from 09:00 to 18:00 (SAST) to practice and to discuss any questions regarding the logistics/practical arrangements. If presenters/moderators are unable to rehearse on their allocated day, they are welcome to use their link on any of the other two alternate days.

On Monday, 25 October 2021, all registered delegates will receive a link to join the live sessions and a separate link to access the symposium microsite to watch the pre-recorded presentations and posters. Recordings of the live sessions will also be available on the microsite within 24 hours after the live event and the content of the microsite will remain accessible to all registered delegates for a month post-symposium (until 5 December 2021).

We want to encourage all registered students (or recent graduates that finished in the past 6 months with their studies) to enter the ISHS Young Minds Awards (for more information please see <https://www.ishs.org/young-minds-award>). During the symposium, these entries will be judged by a special committee and one award will be given for the best oral presentation and one award to the best poster by a junior presenter and first author of the submitted work. All entrants should be younger than 35 years. Please contact Anscha (jjv2@sun.ac.za) if you wish to participate.

Authors of oral presentations are required to prepare a manuscript of their work, which will be published in Acta Horticulturae. For poster presenters it is optional to submit full-text articles. The deadline for these full-length article submissions has been extended to Monday, 22 November 2021. Articles should be submitted via the ROSA system.

We are looking forward to “meet you” all (virtually) on the 31st October 2021 for the symposium opening session!

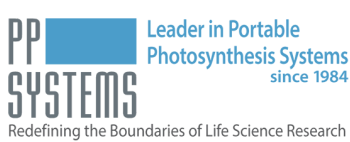
